Dedication Ceremony to Mark Suspension Bridge Opening

The new Suspension Bridge will be opened to students tomorrow at 1 p.m.

University President Deane W. Malott and the designer of the bridge, S. C. Hollister, Prof Emeritus of the College of Civil Engineering, will speak at the dedi-

cation ceremonies to be held on the north side of the bridge at noon. The ceremonies are being sponsored by the Executive Committee of the Student Government.

Among the invited guests are John F. Burton, Vice President in charge of Business, Julius F. Weinhold, Director of Physical Plant, Building, and Properties, John W. Humphreys, Assistant Director, C. A. Hanson, Dean of the University Faculty, and Morris Bishop, Kappa Alpha Professor of Romance Literature, Emeritus, and University Historian.

The old Suspension Bridge was condemned two years ago after an examination showed that its concrete base was crumbling and that the steel structure had been weakened.
