Group Plans Spring Fete

The plans and schedule for Spring Weekend - 1961 were announced today by Bruce Zwinglestein, chairman of the weekend executive committee. The theme of the weekend is to be "The Greatest Show on Earth", and in following the basic pattern of past Spring Weekends, both a Dance and Concert have been scheduled in addition to the traditional Saturday morning float parade.

Ray Charles will be appearing at a Lynah Hall dance scheduled for 9 p.m. Friday evening, accompanied by a 12-piece orchestra and his singing group, the Raelets. Announcement of the artists to be appearing at a concert scheduled for 10:30 p.m. Saturday evening has been withheld pending completion of contractual arrangements.

The Saturday morning parade will feature a record number of entries from fraternities and sororities as well as other campus living units, and a large number of bands from the Ithaca area. Prizes will be offered in each of the competitive classes.

The Ray Charles Dance and Saturday evening Concert are the first weekend events ever to be held in Lynah Hall, and according to the Executive Committee, the move was made in view of the fact that Lynah Hall is air conditioned, has permanent seating and better acoustics than Barton Hall.

Emphasis was placed on the fact that "The Greatest Show on Earth" was not so much intended to provide a "theme" for the Weekend as it was to suggest ideas for
