Univ. Offers Full Weekend For Parents

Parent's Weekend will officially begin to the strains of the University's Repertoire Concert Band on the steps of Willard Straight Hall this afternoon. Approximately 2,500 parents are expected to attend the weekend which is sponsored by Student Government.

University President Deane W. Malott will welcome parents at a convocation in Alice Statler Auditorium at 8:30 p.m. tonight and successive addresses will be made by Richard G. Buckles '62, Theodore Lowi, of the Department of Government.

The deans of the various undergraduate schools and colleges will be introduced at the convocation and a selection of University songs will be presented by the Glee Club. A reception for the parents will follow in Statler Hall.

A full slate of activities is planned for tomorrow, beginning with tours of the John M. Olin Library. At noon a chicken barbeque for parents and students will be held in Barton Hall.

A symposium entitled "Cornell—A Look at Her Past and a Look to Her Future" will begin in Statler Auditorium at 2:30 p.m. tomorrow. John Summerskill, Vice President for Student Affairs, will moderate and the speakers will be University Vice President J. L. Zwingle and Professors Milton R. Konvitz of the School of In-

ustrial and Labor Relations and
Arthur M. Mizener of the English
Department.

The University Glee Club will
present its annual Parent's Week-
end concert in Bailey Hall at 8:30
Saturday night. This will be fol-
lowed by an open house in Wil-
lard Straight Hall from 10 p.m.
to midnight. There will be music,
dancing and entertainment in the
Straight Cafeteria.

To aid parents with their ques-
tions and sightseeing problems, stu-
dent guides will be on hand and
tours will be offered regularly
from the Main Desk in Willard
Straight Hall. In addition an in-
formation desk has been set up
in the Straight Lobby.
