- *Cornellians* sends two dedicated emails per month to all alumni
 - ▶ Class Notes/In Memoriam highlight email
 - First Sunday of every month
 - "From" name: Cornellians
 - Subject line: "Your November updates from alumni, trending stories, and more!" or similar
 - Email category: News and university announcements
 - ▶ *Cornellians* recap newsletter
 - Fourth Tuesday of every month
 - "From" name: Cornellians
 - Subject line: "Your November recap" or similar
 - Email category: Connect with Cornell weekly
- *Cornellians* stories are featured in the all-alumni newsletter each Tuesday and in the **Chronicle's** newsletter each Friday
- New stories are published 3-4 times per week on the **Cornellians** site
- *Cornellians* shares new content on their **Facebook** and **Twitter** pages
- New **Class Notes** column published every other month
- New **In Memoriam** column published every month
